INTRO TO MUSEUMKEY



What is MuseumKey?

Museum Key is an online portal that allows library users to reserve or print passes for entry into museums and other cultural institutions. **IT'S FREE!**

What can I get with MuseumKey?

Delaware County Libraries offer passes to over 40 museums, zoos, and gardens. Passes may be reserved up to 30 days in advance. Each patron may have up to **3 reservations** for different dates. Each patron may check out 1 pass at a time.

What types of passes are available?

Physical Pass: a physical pass is checked out at **your local library** to present to the museum for entry and then returned to the library for the next person. Physical passes may be checked out for 3 days.

Print and Go Pass: go to **delcolibraries.org** and click on "museum passes" to find **additional** museums to visit. These passes can be printed at home to present to the museum for entry. Print and Go passes do not need to be returned to a library. They are identified with a small printer icon by the museum name.

Who can use MuseumKey?

Passes may be reserved by adult card holders (18 and older) who do not have more than \$250 in fines or fees on their account.

What do I need to use MuseumKey?

Your valid library card number.
